

Welcome Park Visitor:

We hope you enjoy Hearst San Simeon State Park, with its recreational opportunities, camping, wildlife, nature trails and beaches. For your safety and the protection of our natural and cultural resources, please remember a few of the following rules and regulations:

- Check-in time is 2:00 pm. Check-out time is 12:00 noon.
- Quiet hours are 10:00 pm – 6:00 am.
- Generators may be operated from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm.
- Dogs are welcome in the campground and picnic areas while on a six foot leash or in vehicles or tents. Dogs are not allowed on trails or beaches.
- Wood may be purchased from the camp host. Gathering of firewood in the park is not allowed.
- Per California State Law, visitors under the age of 18 must wear a helmet when riding bicycles, in-line skates, scooters or skateboards in the park. Bicycles are not allowed on the nature trails.
- To protect the park vegetation, please park on paved parking pads and camp within designated areas.
- At San Simeon Creek campground, a maximum of 3 vehicles/8 people are permitted per campsite.
- At Washburn campground, a maximum of 2 vehicles/8 people are permitted per campsite.
- Coin-operated showers are for the use of San Simeon Creek campers only.
